A Chinese Filipino game played during the Mid-Autumn Festival

Setup: 6 dice, 1 porcelain bowl, 63 prizes (see column for suggested values)

Rules:

- Only one roll per player per round.
- Reroll if the dice fall out of the bowl or are not laying flat.
- Prizes for tiers 2 through 6 are handed out immediately.
- Record players and combinations for rolls eligible for Tsiong Guan.
- Winner of Tsiong Guan is announced at the end of the game.
- Tsong Chiang is a roll of Red 6, which immediately ends gameplay. Winner takes all.
